Dear Parents,

JUNIOR SPORTS ACADEMY (JSA) SELECTION TRIALS 2024 **PARENTS' NOMINATION**

1. MOE will be conducting the selection trials for interested Primary 4 and Primary 5 students for the Junior Sports Academy (JSA) in April 2024. Schools will be nominating suitable students for the selection trials. However, if you wish to nominate your child for the selection trials, you may also do so by completing the attached 'Parent's Nomination Form' (Annex A) and return it to the school by 4 Mar 2024.
2. The trials will evaluate your child's general physical ability; mainly your child's natural ability of agility, balance, coordination, speed and power. There will not be any test on sport-specific skills. Therefore, no training or preparation is required for the trial. Sufficient time will be given during the trial for children to familiarise themselves with the items.
3. Based on the trial results, selected students and their parents will be informed (mid-May) and invited to a Parents Engagement Session to understand more about the programme. Students who opt-in to participate in the JSA programme will start in Term 3, 2024.
4. The aim of the programme is for students to explore, discover and develop their areas of interest and strengths across a wide range of physical activities. JSA seeks to provide broad-based opportunities with the following objectives:
 - a) Budding sporting talents will be identified and developed with a broad-based physical sports programme, to strengthen their overall physical competencies and motivation in sports at the primary school level.
 - b) These students will explore and discover their strength and passion in a range of sports at the primary school level, and subsequently to make an informed choice to commit to one of them with more targeted support from schools and relevant sports organisations at the secondary school level.

Duration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> About 2.5 hours (after registration)
Student to note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Student to be in the school's PE attire and school/sports shoes. There is <u>no need</u> to bring any sports equipment. Bring <u>student Ezlink card</u> and a water bottle. Student should have consumed his/her meal prior reporting (preferably 1-2hrs before)
Parent(s) and accompanying adult(s) to note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Arrive at the specified reporting time. Parents/adults to take note of their child's group number during registration. Parents/adults are not allowed into the testing halls. Parents/adults can either wait at the dismissal hall or leave the venue and return to pick up their children at the dismissal hall. The estimated waiting time is approximately 2.5 hours (from registration) due to the large number of participants.
Condition of Entry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Security checks will be conducted for all adults entering the venue. No outside food is allowed to be brought into the venue.
