P1 English Language Learning Journey to The Singapore Zoo

The Primary 1 cohort will be going for a Learning Journey to the Singapore Zoo. The programme aims to provide students with an outdoor learning experience and help them relate what they have learnt during their English lessons to a real-life context. Students will visit various zones and exhibits to learn about different animals. The learning journey will take place during school hours so students will report and be dismissed from school at the usual timings.

P2 English Language Learning Journey to Science Centre

The Primary 2 cohort will be going for a Learning Journey to the Singapore Science Centre. The programme aims to provide students with an extension of learning of English lessons to real-life application to identify, observe, compare and draw different types of animals with shells as well as identify the different parts of shells and what those animals have in common. Students will also explore the Singapore Science Centre's ecogarden.
