## **Key School Level Programmes**

### Pre-PSLE Study Break for Primary 6 Students

The school will be implementing a three-day study break for the P6 students from 22 September (Monday) to 24 September (Wednesday) to support their well-being prior to PSLE. During the study break, P6 students are strongly encouraged to remain at home and do their revision. The school may request for selected students to return to school during the study break. Parents/Guardians of selected students will be separately informed. Lessons are as usual for Primary 1 to Primary 5 during this period.

The Student Care Centre (SCC) in school will also remain open in the afternoons from 1.30pm to 7pm during the study break.
